Visit Morro Bay Board of Directors Meeting Minutes

1. CALL TO ORDER - Board Chair Amish Patel Called the meeting to order at 9:02 am

City Council member Jeff Eckels thanked Visit Morro Bay for all we are doing and then announced that there is a volunteer position open on the City's Planning Commission.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR REPORT

3. Executive Director Report (20 min)

Staff will provide an update on current projects, reporting, and areas of focus for the months ahead.

Michael gave an update on the soft launch of the new website.

Branding: Michael stated that the Pensara photo shoot was completed and that a lot of great shots were captured.

Events: Michael stated that he would be presenting up coming events later in the meeting.

Finances: Michael stated that there is \$335,776.10 in the operating account and \$899,816.20 in the reserve account.

International: Michael spoke on his participation at IPW this year and stated that it was a good event and that international travel is picking up.

Michael stated that the UK marketing group representing us is doing on going trainings of tour agents and operators.

Michael stated that the German marketing company representing us brought a FAM to Morro Bay from May 18th – 20th. He stated that the trip was successful.

Reports: Michael explained the TOT and STR reports. He stated that Morro Bay and SLO CAL is showing a slow down for the start of summer. There is a significant slow down in other areas of SLO County. This is the first time in four years that there has been such a slowdown.

Marketing: Michael stated that the Expedia VCA Co-op is live with a spend of \$60,000.00.

Michael stated that the November 2024 – June 2025 Expedia Co-op had an ad spend of \$59,990.00 with room nights brought in at 4,445. Revenue was \$778,500 this is a return on investment of 3 to 1.

Promotions: Michael spoke on the Adventure month promotion that Mariana created.

6. Visit Morro Bay Board of Directors Officer Selection (10min) motion required

7. Avocado Margarita Festival Sponsorship Approval – Sept 2025 (10min) motion required

Board to hear proposal from Morro Bay Chamber of Commerce, for the Avocado Margarita festival sponsorship. Board to discuss and potentially approve funds.

Michael spoke on the history of the Avocado Margarita Festival and introduced Chamber of Commerce CEO Dina Lundquist.

Dina first took a few moments to talk about how the Chamber of Commerce is reimagining itself and what they are doing for businesses in Morro Bay.

Dina presented her proposal for bringing back the Avocado Margarita Festival this September 20th and is asking for a sponsorship of \$20,000.

The Board discussed. They though it would be better if it were a two-day event instead of one.

Board Chair Amish Patel asked if someone would like to make a motion.

PUBLIC COMMENT: None

ACTION: Board member Chris Kostecka made a motion to support the Avocado Margarita Festival for \$20,000 with the provision that it be a two-day event.

8. Approval of Reserve Funds for VCA Co-op Expedia Campaign (10mins) motion required

Board to approve funds for the events or approve events sponsorship sub-committee.

Michael presented upcoming events and commented that the Board could create an events subcommittee if they felt necessary.

The Board did not feel it was necessary to create a subcommittee at this time.

Michael then presented each event.

The Board discussed. They agreed on the amounts for all but the Central Coast Writers Conference. It was decided to give \$2500. It was decided to do one vote for all the events presented at the same time.

Tunes at Tidelands – sponsorship \$5,000 Morro Bay Triathlon – sponsorship \$10,000 SLO Cal WSL OPEN – sponsorship \$30,000 Central Coast Writers Conference – \$5,000.

ACTION: Board member Mark Roemer made a motion to approve Tunes at tidelands for \$5,000, Morro Bay Triathlon for \$10,000, SLO Cal WSL OPEN for \$30,000, and the Central Coast Writers Conference for \$2500.00 with the requirement that they push Morro Bay a writers retreat destination.
